Dear Parents:

Greetings from the Central Office. The purpose of this letter is to apprise you of a boiler replacement and asbestos abatement project that is planned for Kathleen H. Ryerson School during the summer. This summer, the Ryerson School boilers will be replaced and the project will also include the removal of asbestos in the boiler room. As a result of this summer project, Ryerson School will be closed to the general public beginning on Monday, June 29, 2009 through Friday, July 31, 2009. The outside playground area will remain open and accessible but the interior of the building will be closed.

As you may know, state and federal regulations require all asbestos abatement procedures to be highly regulated and monitored. Dr. Mark Granville of Brooks Environmental Consulting will serve as the school district's consultant throughout the project. Dr. Granville is a licensed asbestos management inspector and planner and has been working with the Madison Public Schools for over twenty years. His direct consultation will ensure complete compliance with all regulatory processes and procedures associated with the removal of asbestos.
